Core refresher	4 hour Class is a requirement for veteran drivers to maintain their School Bus Certificate. It must be taken every 4 Years
CPR	This class will teach the basics of Cardiopulmonary resuscitation
CRS/Safety Support vest	Proper securement of Car seats and Safety vests
Field trips	Advanced CORE unit C
Finding something solid	This class will look at accidents involving stationary objects
First Aid	THIS class meets the ODE requirements
Hands On pre trip	Watch a pre-trip including verbalization
