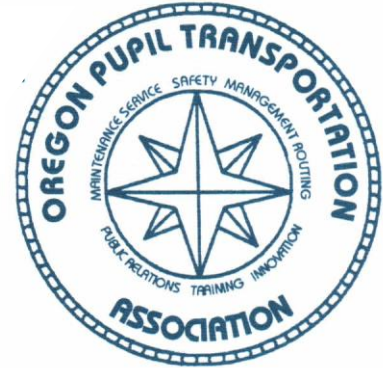
Summer Conference: TJ Crockett/Robin Biden

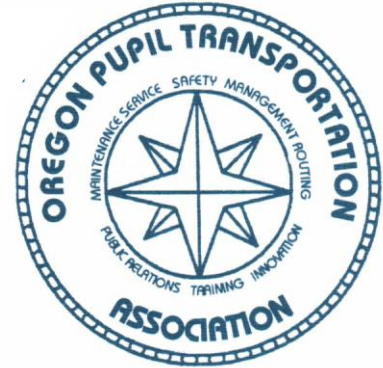
